### White Wines

#### **Isenhower Cellars, White Paintbrush, Walla Walla, Washington**

This is a 100% Roussanne grape varietal that has a pleasantly rich mouthfeel. It shows notes of honey and apricot and has a crisp and clean finish, but low acidity. This differentiates it from the typical sauvignon blanc and pinot gris.

#### **Château Ste. Michelle 'Indian Wells' Chardonnay, Columbia Valley, Washington**

Pineapple and mango aromas with hints of vanilla, caramel and brown sugar spices. This is a luscious Chardonnay with a soft, subtle finish.

#### **Heron Chardonnay, California**

Laely Heron is a woman who is passionate about wine. This passion comes through in her wonderfully rich, expressive, and fruity chardonnay. It is perfectly balanced with a core of grapefruit and citrus flavors that end up complex and delicious on the finish.



#### **A to Z Pinot Gris, Oregon**

Citrus aromas with lime blossoms, lychee, honeysuckle and white peaches creates a clean, crisp Pinot Gris. The concentrated attack is pure and bright with wonderful lush fruit and mineral notes. It is framed by ripe acidity that makes this classic Oregon Pinot Gris an inviting wine with a long lasting finish.

#### **Fauna Sauvignon Blanc, Chile**

This is a classic example of the Sauvignon Blanc grape. The wine fills the mouth with tropical fruit flavors and it has a light body with a tart and juicy finish. Perfect for light dishes and warm weather sipping.

#### **Sokol Blosser, Evolution, Willamette Valley**

Riesling based wine blended together with 8 other grape varietals tie together perfectly, creating a smooth, layered white wine. Fresh and floral with hints sweetness throughout.

#### **Buty "Conner Lee" Chardonnay, Walla Walla, Washington**

Produced by one of Walla Walla's best known winemakers, this Chardonnay is consistently recognized as one of the top Chardonnay's in all of Washington. It has aromas of bright green apples and a soft scent of citrus fruit. The mouthfeel is rich and buttery, yet the finish has the acidity to balance and refresh the palette.

## Champagne & Sparkling Wines

### **Cuvée Française, France**

*This sparkling wine comes from the South of France and it is made exactly like the wines of Champagne. It is a chardonnay blend that shows aromas of green apple and stone fruits. It is light, dry, and crisp, making it a great aperitif.*

### **J. Laurens, France**

This sparkling wine is also made in France, but it is made just South of the official Champagne appellation. However, for a fraction of the price of champagne, this delivers all of the flavor. It is rich and complex. Yeast, bread, and almond aromas fill the glass making it a great pairing for food and cake.



### **Schramsberg Mirabelle Brut Rose**

This sparkling wine exhibits fresh, elegant and toasty aromas that lead into lively and delicious fruit flavors on the palate.

### **Iron Horse Wedding Cuvée, Napa Valley**

Light citrus and pear, with a touch of yeast creates very smooth and delicate crispness on the pallet.

### **Tattinger, France**

Elegant, firm structure with a velvety texture and a crisp, dry finish.

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### Red Wines

#### **A to Z Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon**

The dark spices on the nose and palate complement the flavors you would expect from a good Oregon Pinot Noir: blackberry, raspberry, black cherry and earth. The oak profile is restrained and the natural acidity gives the wine precision and tautness.

#### **Balboa Merlot, Columbia Valley, Washington**

This wine shows a beautiful balance of tannins and acidity while the palate offers leather and anise with pomegranate, tea, and pie cherries. Classic “Mirage” Vineyard Merlot.



#### **Château Ste. Michelle ‘Indian Wells’ Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley, Washington**

Classic flavors of rich, velvety raspberry, bittersweet chocolaté, with a hint of pepper and cinnamon.

#### **Once “The Table” Cabernet-Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California**

Last year, America's finest sommeliers competed in a friendly blending competition to create their version of a perfect wine to serve with food. Judged by a panel composed of a master sommelier and two of France's premier winemakers. This was the winning blend. The fruit comes from several of the Napa Valleys most recognized vineyards. Luscious and classic Napa valley fruit, this is a wonderful wine that will be remembered by everyone.

#### **Willow Crest Syrah, Yakima Valley, Washington**

After growing grapes for other winemakers in the Yakima Valley for more than a decade, David Minick realized a long-time dream of producing his own wine with the opening of Willow Crest Winery in 1995. This wine is completely grown and harvested by hand and it shows rich flavors of dark berries that travel through your palate and hints of smoke create a lingering finish.

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### Red Wines

#### **Pendulum Red Blend, Walla Walla, Washington**

Produced in Walla Walla, this award winning wine is a blend of Cabernet, Merlot, Sangiovese, Syrah, and Cabernet Franc. The end product is a delicious balance of berry, chocolate, and spice flavors.



#### **Kenwood 'Reserve' Zinfandel, Sonoma**

Full bodied with tar and blackberry aromas. A medium yet bold juicy wine with a long finish

#### **Lazy River Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon**

In 2000, Ned and Kirsten Lumpkin planted 36 acres of vines known as The Lazy River Vineyard in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. The Pinot Noir produced from this vineyard is a blend of seven different clones. It is medium-dark Ruby; ripe, dark-cherry, raspberry and cola with underlying earthiness and minerality. It is soft on the mid-palate with a medium to long finish.
